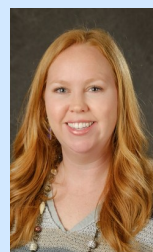

Winners will have their names, grades, counties, and winning piggy banks shared via social media. Winners will also receive a certificate.

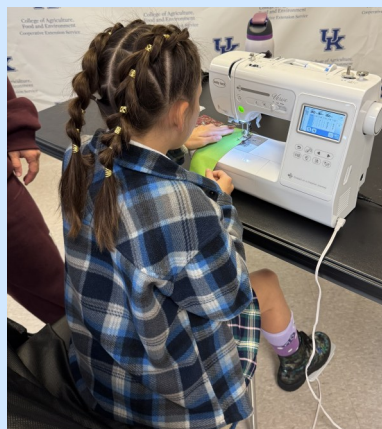
Get creative and start designing your piggy bank today!
